ST. IGNATIUS OF LOYOLA was born in 1491 in Spain. The youngest of thirteen children, his mother died soon after his birth and his father died when he was seven. Ignatius lived with a local noble family where he fulfilled the duties of a page, introducing him to the idea of knighthood and military service. As a result, Ignatius dreamed of being a great military officer. Captivated by thoughts of worldly honor and glory, he became a soldier at seventeen. For the next twelve years he fought in many battles and advanced in rank. In 1521 Ignatius was wounded in battle and bedridden for months. When he asked for books to read, he hoped to receive books on chivalry and romance, but instead was given *The Life of Christ* and *Flowers of the Saints*. As he read these books, he became inspired and imagined himself living a saintly life.

After his recovery, Ignatius desired to make a pilgrimage to the Holy Land, but first went to Montserrat. There spent three days preparing for confession of the sins of his whole life. Ignatius revealed to his confessor his intention to devote his entire life to the service of God. After confession, he consecrated himself to our Lord and our Blessed Mother. After his stay in Montserrat, Ignatius journeyed to Manresa. His months there were months of deep conversion.

It was in Manresa that Ignatius wrote what has become one of the great spiritual classics in the Church: The Spiritual Exercises. Ignatius spent the next several years studying at Barcelona, Alcalá, and Salamanca. His writings were scrutinized by the Spanish Inquisition, and he was imprisoned a few times before being cleared of heresy. He moved to Paris to obtain a master's degree in theology, where he met Francis Xavier and Peter Faber, who would later also become saints.

In 1537, Ignatius and his companions moved to Venice and were ordained priests. Then in 1540, they co-founded the Society of Jesus. The following year, Ignatius was elected the first superior, a role he held until his death. St. Ignatius is one of the most inspirational figures in the history of the Church. He died 1556 leaving behind a spiritual classic in The Spiritual Exercises, helped found the Jesuits who became one of the most consequential religious orders in the Church, and left behind other writings, including an estimated 7,000 letters, filled with his wisdom. His feast day is July 31.

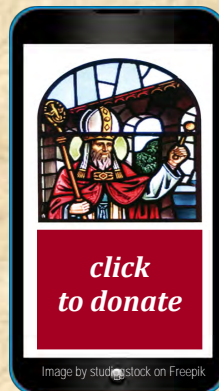

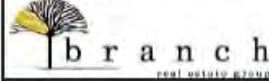
Matrimony: Engaged couples are to call the parish office before any other arrangements are made. A minimum of six months is needed.

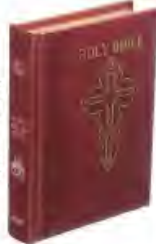
