DRVC Statement Regarding Bankruptcy

The four-year long Bankruptcy of the Diocese of Rockville Centre is hopefully drawing to a close. There is an agreement in principle which should end the bankruptcy within a few months.

The Diocese of Rockville Centre entered in Chapter 11 Bankruptcy (Reorganization) in order to accomplish three goals:

- 1. To compensate those survivors of sexual abuse whose claims were brought forward during the so-called "window" which New York State opened, allowing historical claims to be addressed;
- 2. To allow the Diocese to emerge in a financial position which allows the Church to continue its mission to the people of Long Island; and,
- 3. To provide legal protection for the parishes of the Diocese against future claims relating to historical abuse cases.

As has been reported in *Newsday*, the total of the proposed settlement is slightly more than 323 million dollars. Of that, 234.8 million dollars will be paid by the Diocese of Rockville Center and its related organizations, including the parishes. 85 million will be paid by insurance.

The exact amount each parish will be required to pay has not been finalized. While the amounts of the parish contribution will be considerable, they will not be impossible for the parishes to bear, and they will allow all the parishes to continue in their mission. The payments will be made from current parish savings, and no future donations will go to this settlement.

No parishes will close because of the Bankruptcy Settlement.

For extremely complicated legal reasons, each parish will also have to enter Chapter 11 Bankruptcy. Please do not be alarmed.

This will be an abbreviated, simplified bankruptcy, **which will not affect the activities of parishes in any way**. This parish bankruptcy should last no longer than 48 hours. After which, the parishes will be able to share in the protection against future historic claims and against possible litigation.

While there are no doubt many conflicting feelings regarding the bankruptcy and the Settlement – and I am ready to speak to you about them, if you wish – be assured that this is the best and only possible way forward for the Diocese and the parishes.
