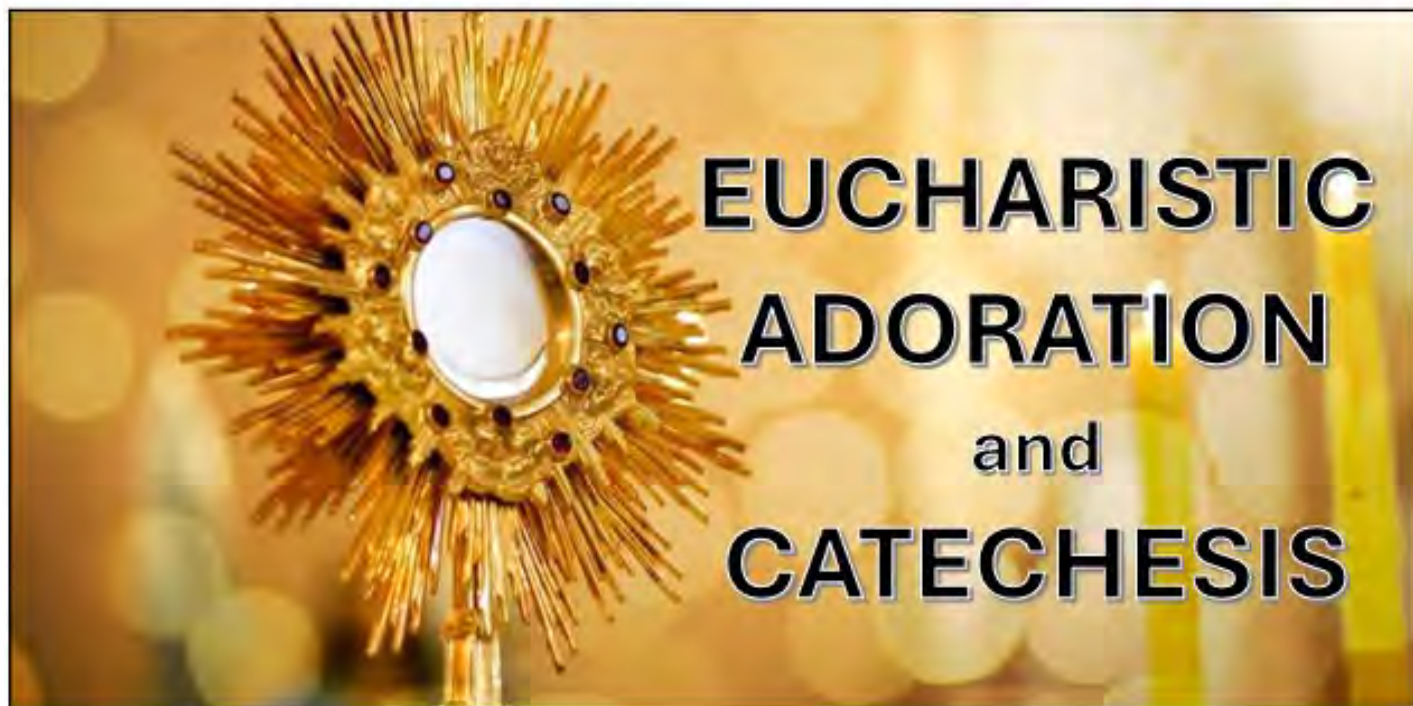

What exactly *is* a parish? If one attends Holy Mass on Sundays and Holy days, one could say he attends one. Others may say they belong to one because they are registered at a specific church.

But it is something more.

Parish comes from the Greek word *paroikia*, meaning "sojourning in a foreign land," from *paroikos*, meaning "dwelling beside, stranger, sojourner." The etymology of this word illuminates its true purpose in the Catholic tradition as it was once understood by Holy Mother Church's children. To belong to a Parish is to be a sojourner, a stranger in a strange land, wayfaring to our rendezvous with our Heavenly Father, where we hope to join our fellow parishioners in receiving our eternal reward.

In an increasingly pagan society that has distanced itself from its Christian beginnings, the sojourning soul is confronted with the grim reality that this world no longer holds the commandments of the Lord as eternal truths. One must understand what his parish is, his obligations to it, and its obligations to him. One must come to know what his role is, joining his fellow sojourners.

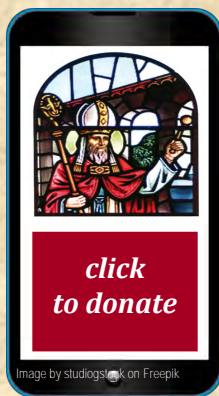
