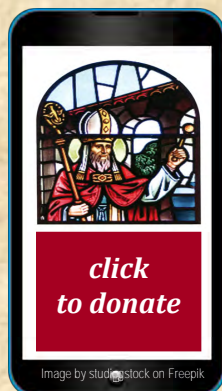

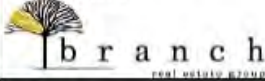
Matrimony: Engaged couples are to call the parish

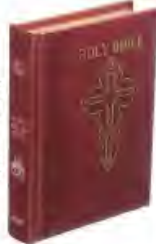
